- Assume all of the risks and accept personal responsibility for any damages I may incur due to injury, illness, disability, or death (including, without limitation, any damages resulting from exposure to COVID-19), relative to attendance at CMC WinterMusic and related events and activities.
- Release, waive, and discharge from responsibility the Conference, any affiliate thereof, and its Officers, Board of Directors, employees, and agents (collectively the “Released Parties”) from any demands, claims, losses, or damages I may have or incur on account of injury (including death or damage to property) caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the Released Parties or otherwise at or in connection with CMC WinterMusic. I also covenant not to sue the Conference with respect to any such demands, claims, losses, or damages.
